THE MOST HOLY TRINITY



To grasp the central importance of the mystery of the Trinity in our faith, let us look at how we pray to the Trinity.

A very common prayer — which, strangely, a lot of Catholics don't know how to say — is the 'doxology' or praise of God: 'Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit'. (Better learn it now; this is how we are to praise God for all eternity in the Kingdom of Heaven.)

Our leading liturgical prayers end with an explicit enunciation of the mystery of the Trinity: 'Through Our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever.'

Our most common prayer, which we say so often we may not even notice what it says, is the Sign of the Cross: 'In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit'.

This prayer of words and action is significant in several ways.

The cross of Jesus is the first sign of the Christian, and it is the first sign of the sacrament of Baptism: after the parents and godparents agree to pass on their faith to their child, the sign of the cross is traced on the child's forehead by the minister, the parents and the godparents.

The sign of the cross both testifies that our salvation has been won by Jesus through bearing the cross, and declares that we too bear the same cross.

With this prayer we also claim the name of the Trinity as we pray to the Father, through the Son, in the Spirit. We claim the cross of Jesus as our own, our badge.

We cannot do without the Trinity even if we are unable to fathom its mystery.

The Holy Trinity

Today is a special day in the church called Trinity Sunday. Do you know what Trinity means? Trinity means three-in-one. God is made up of three persons - the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. That is what we call the Trinity.

As simple as that sounds, the Trinity is hard to understand. The three persons in the Blessed Trinity are all equal but different. We cannot understand this, but we believe it because Jesus taught it. It is a mystery to us - something we can think about and wonder about. People have used many different things to try and help explain what the Trinity is. Take for example, an egg. It has three parts- the shell, the white and the yolk, but together it makes up an egg.

Let's pray:

God, we thank you for being all-powerful and all-knowing and for loving us. We thank you for the things in life that we don't completely understand and for giving us the faith tobelieve them anyway. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy spirit, Amen.
