

# SOCCER REGISTRATION FOR SEASON 2022



Dear Families,

All students who would like to play soccer next term need to complete their registration via **QKR under Sports Payments**, together with the applicable registration fee no later than **Sunday March 20<sup>th</sup> 2022**. **Registrations will close on this date.**

**The registration fee is payable at the time of registration otherwise we will be unable to register your child to play.** The registration fee is a flat fee of \$60 per child. This fee includes the non-refundable hire of a sports top that must be returned clean and in good order at the end of the season. It also includes registrations costs, trophy purchase, coach gifts and sausage sizzle to be held at the end of the season. **Please note that school sports vouchers cannot be claimed.**

Players will require navy shorts (school sports shorts) a pair of yellow/gold soccer socks (can be purchased from Port Road Sports/sports shops) and shin pads (compulsory).

**Soccer is a fantastic activity that can only be offered to our children as long as there is ongoing parental assistance.** Each team requires a parent coach and /or manger and if we do not have sufficient assistance then some teams may not go ahead. **Coaches and managers are required to have Catholic Clearance and a completed volunteer package to be able to perform these roles.** Please see the front office to begin this process if required.

We aim to get a high level of participation amongst all boys and girls. Teams are mixed. Giving equitable playing time to all kids and using only positive comments is an expectation of all our coaches. Spectators are also expected to only use positive comments when supporting the teams and individual players as well.

Our school plays in the North West Junior Soccer Association ([www.nwjisa.org.au](http://www.nwjisa.org.au)). Games are held Saturday mornings at either West Lakes or St. Clair (U6 to U11 usually St Clair & U12 at West Lakes Shore). Venues are yet to be confirmed. We finish our season in September with a Soccer Carnival for all U6-U11 teams. Players can also be selected for the State Championships for the under 11, 12 and 13 boys and under 13 girls teams. The 2022 season commences on Saturday May 14<sup>th</sup> 2022.

**Get your registration in NOW.** We are limited in the number of children per team and late registrations may not be accepted or require a late fee. Any requests for special consideration as to team placement must be made at the time of registration and clearly noted on the registration form. The sports committee will do its best to accommodate families however please note that the association have decided that no child is to play below his/her appropriate age group without a medically certified disability.
