## Fees

YMCA is a registered childcare provider allowing the majority of families to receive the Child Care Subsidy (50-85%) off full fees.

Fees are charged on a per session basis (not per hour), and paid via direct debit from a bank account or credit card.

Child Care Subsidy is managed through MyGov Centrelink.
