\$3,514.65

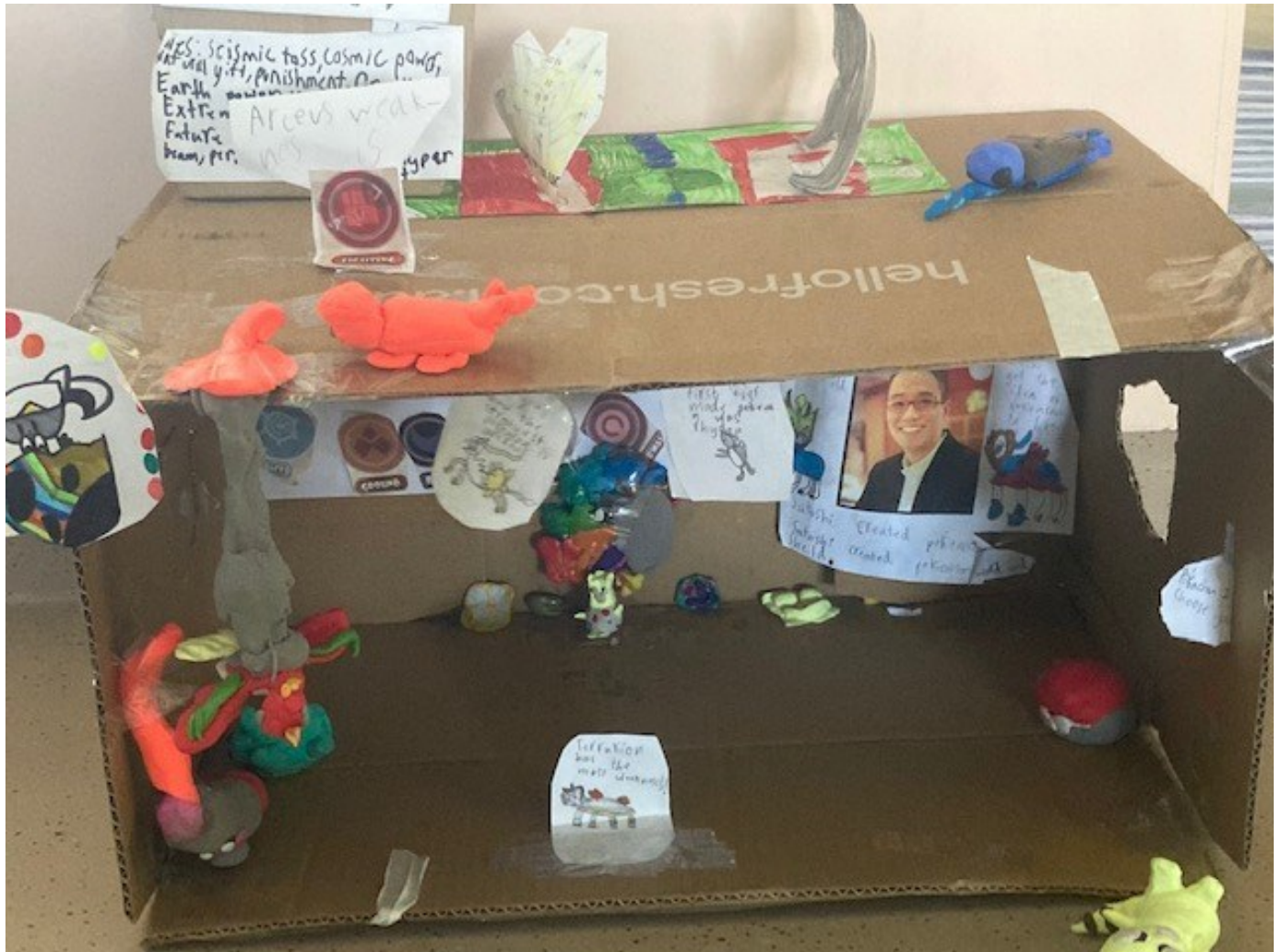
The grand total that our school leaders raised is:

## Social Media and Communication at Rosary School

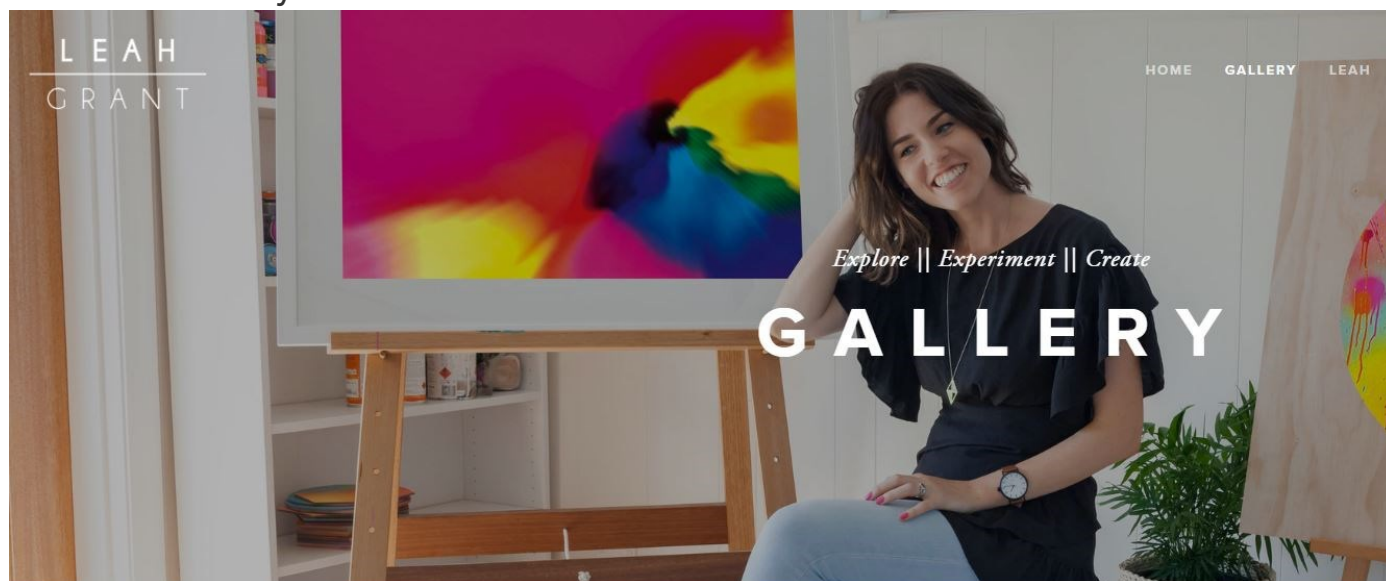
